### FRIENDS OF THE LIBRARY

Friends Co-Chair Julie Konopka reported that the town-wide mailing increased membership by 16 percent, from 255 members to 296 members; new members included 45 families and 25 individuals and several new volunteers.

### DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Brook Berry reported that the January door count statistics issue is resolved. She is investigating the online patron session statistics as they have dropped over the past few months. The reason for the drop may be that the service reporting the statistics may have changed the way it is making its calculations of hits and views.

The snow occurrences have hit the library had because of the many closures the library has had as a result of the storms.

There have been several well attended programs held over the last month, including teens decorating cupcakes, music makers and book bingo.

The budget is currently on track with 60% spent thus far.

Brook provided an insurance update. The current insurance that the library is paying includes employment practices liability insurance for directors and officers insurance, which is covered by the town insurance. There was discussion about such coverage being superfluous since the town provides it.

# FY 15-16 LIBRARY BUDGET

There is a public hearing on the budget on April 20, 2015.
